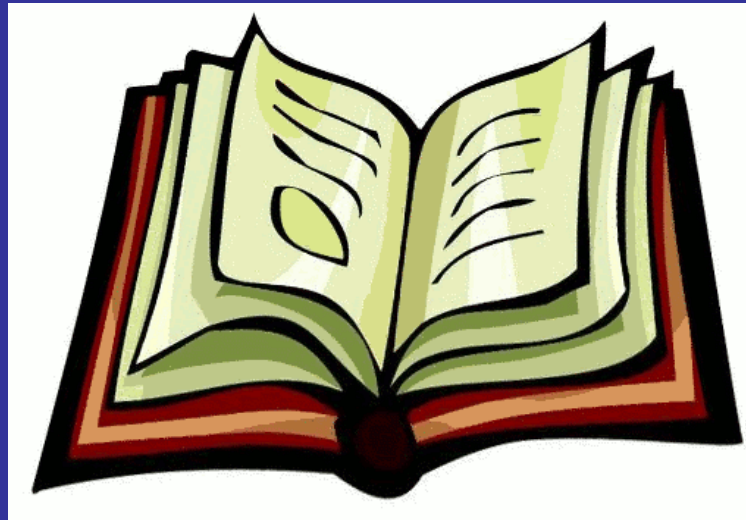

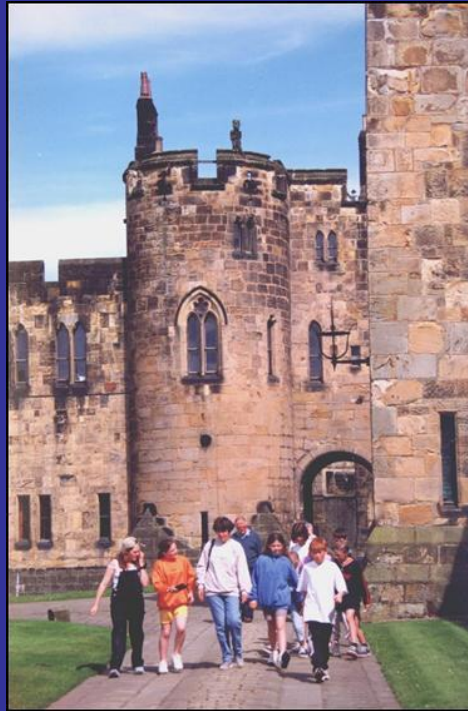


Where is Alnwick Castle?

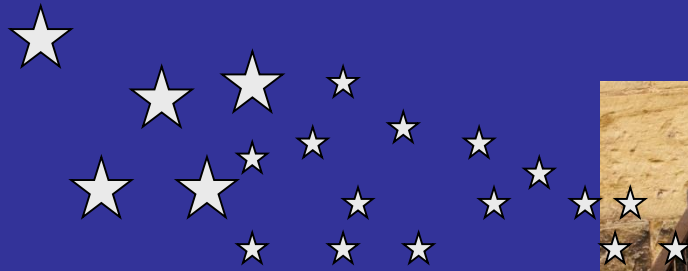

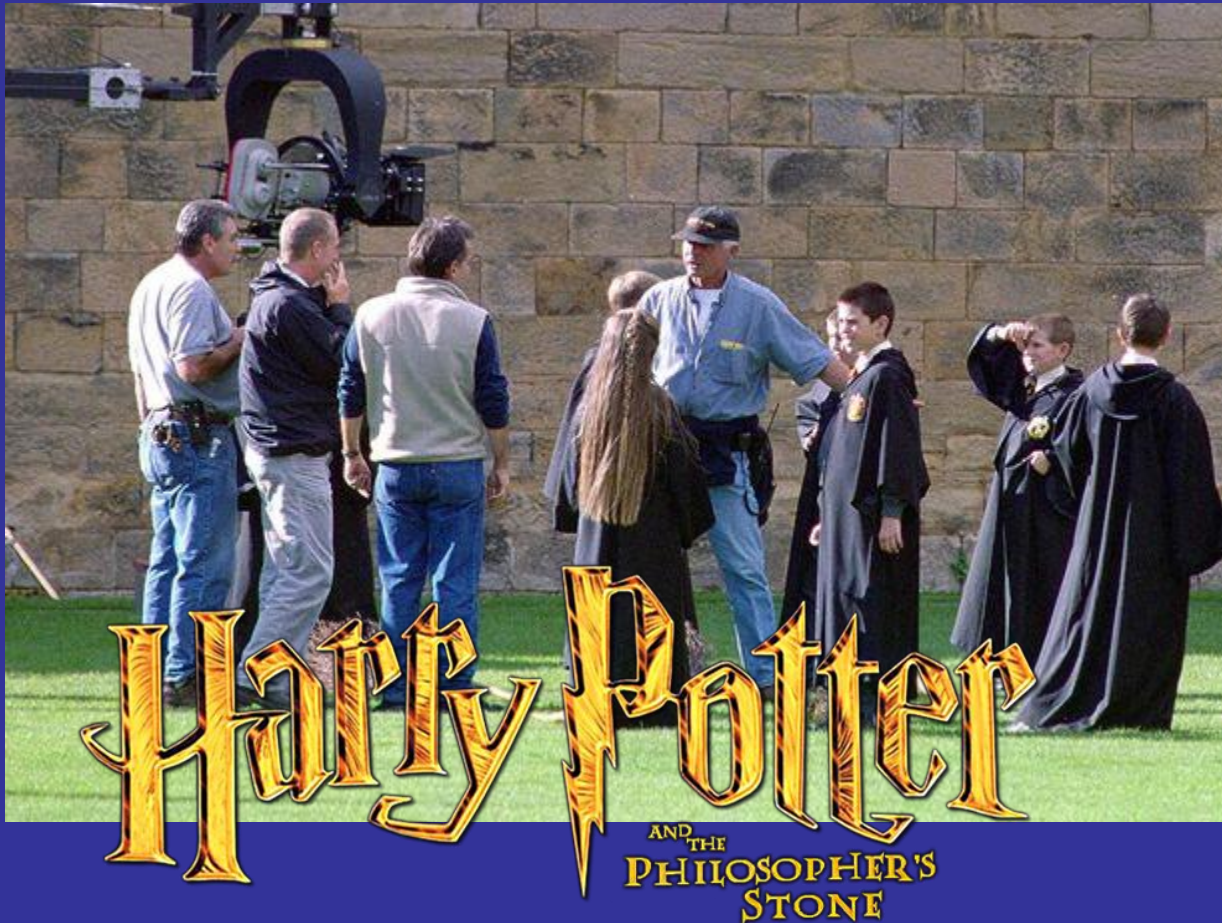


How did this happen?
