After a short twenty-minute ferry crossing the social day participants will reach Mgarr harbour. The guide will lead around the Megalithic temples of Ggantija, the oldest free-standing monuments in the world. This will be followed by visits to the medieval citadel in Victoria, the fjord-like bay at Xlendi and the Azure Window at Dwejra.

At 15.00 participants depart Mgarr Gozo on small vessels for a cruise of Comino visiting Blue lagoon, Crystal lagoon and possibly some caves. The boats will then berth in Marfa Malta at around 16.00 for a direct transfer by coach to the hotel.
