CALL FOR PAPERS

Papers are invited in all areas of social and environmental accounting and environmental and sustainability management accounting. Both full papers and research-in-progress papers (in Portuguese or in English) can be submitted. Discussion and debate will be encouraged with each presentation limited to 20 minutes.

Abstracts can be submitted from now and should be:

- Minimum of 750 words and maximum of 1250;
- Indication of 6 main references;
- Include key words;
- File in a Word document

The Scientific Committee's decisions will be notified by **7th July 2010**.

RESEARCH-IN PROGRESS PAPERS

Any research in-progress projects, which are submitted, should also contain a brief description of the following aspects:

- Research problem;
- Research methodology;
- Database or method for collecting data;
- Expected results (or preliminary results, if available);
- Anticipated and/or experienced difficulties in the course of the project.
