The "Thinking Employment" event 2019 features a programme that will:

- identify and explore **Employability Skills**
- encourage **Reflective Thinking**
- provide the opportunity to sample **Experiential Learning***
- introduce the concept of **Emotional Intelligence**
- assist students to identify and develop skills and self-awareness through **reflection**.

*Experiential learning is the process of learning through experience and is more specifically defined as "learning through reflection of doing"

The programme will be delivered by members of industry and by academics in the disciplines that underpin the conference aims. In Edinburgh the conference events will be held in centrally located, prestigious venues.

A dedicated App will be made available before the conference to help delegates get maximum benefit from the event and to assist with communication between delegates. You will be required to have a facebook account prior to and during the event.

There are 110 places available. Before 30 September there will be a maximum of 5 home students per institute, plus up to 5 "guest" students from outside of the home country, currently studying at your institute. If places are still available at 30 September the allocation of places will increase.
